5. Continue increasing in this manner until the granny square is the desired size.



Moss Stitch Dishcloth

This knit dishcloth features a unique moss stitch that creates a textured and absorbent fabric. This pattern requires some basic knitting skills, such as knitting and purling.

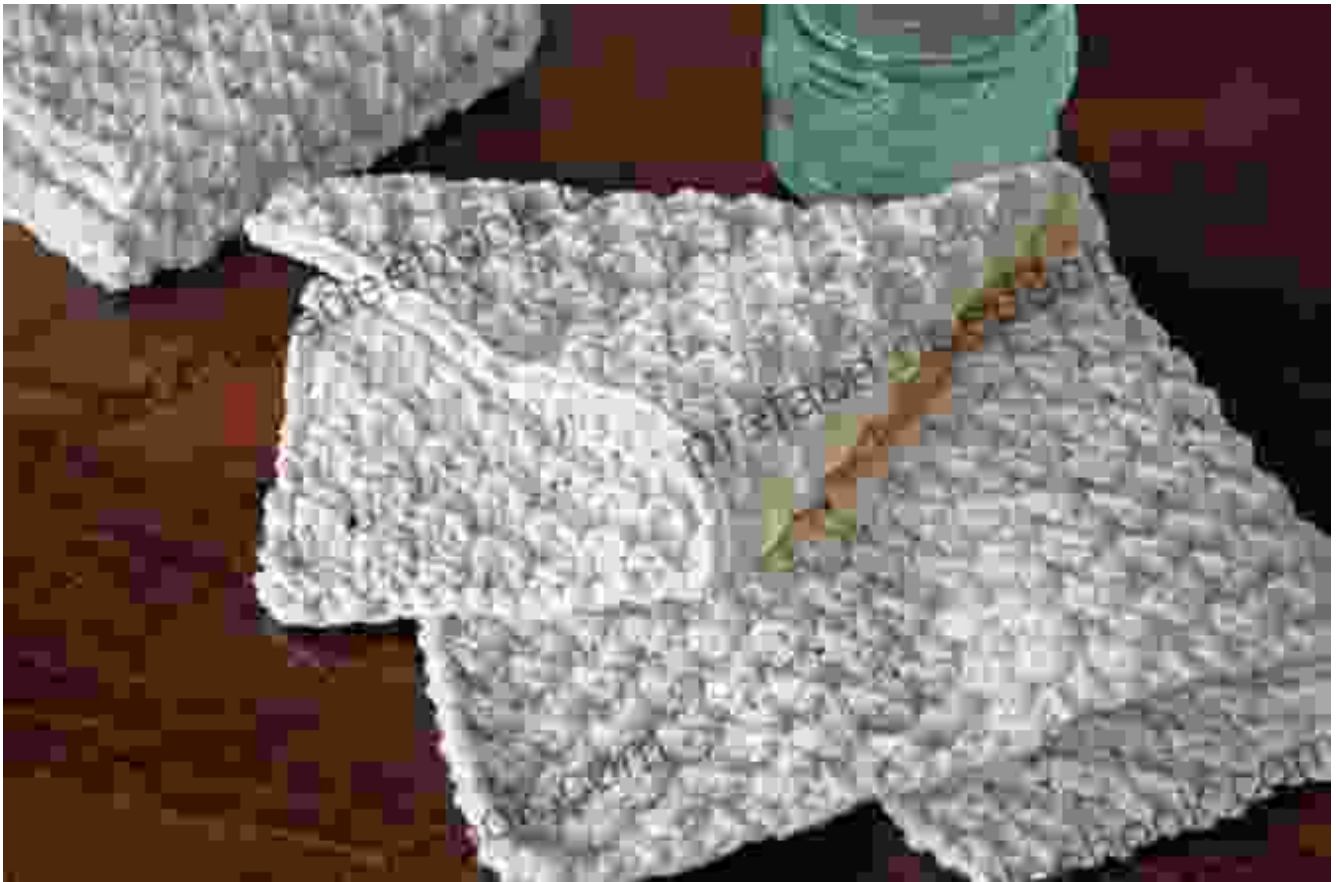
Materials:

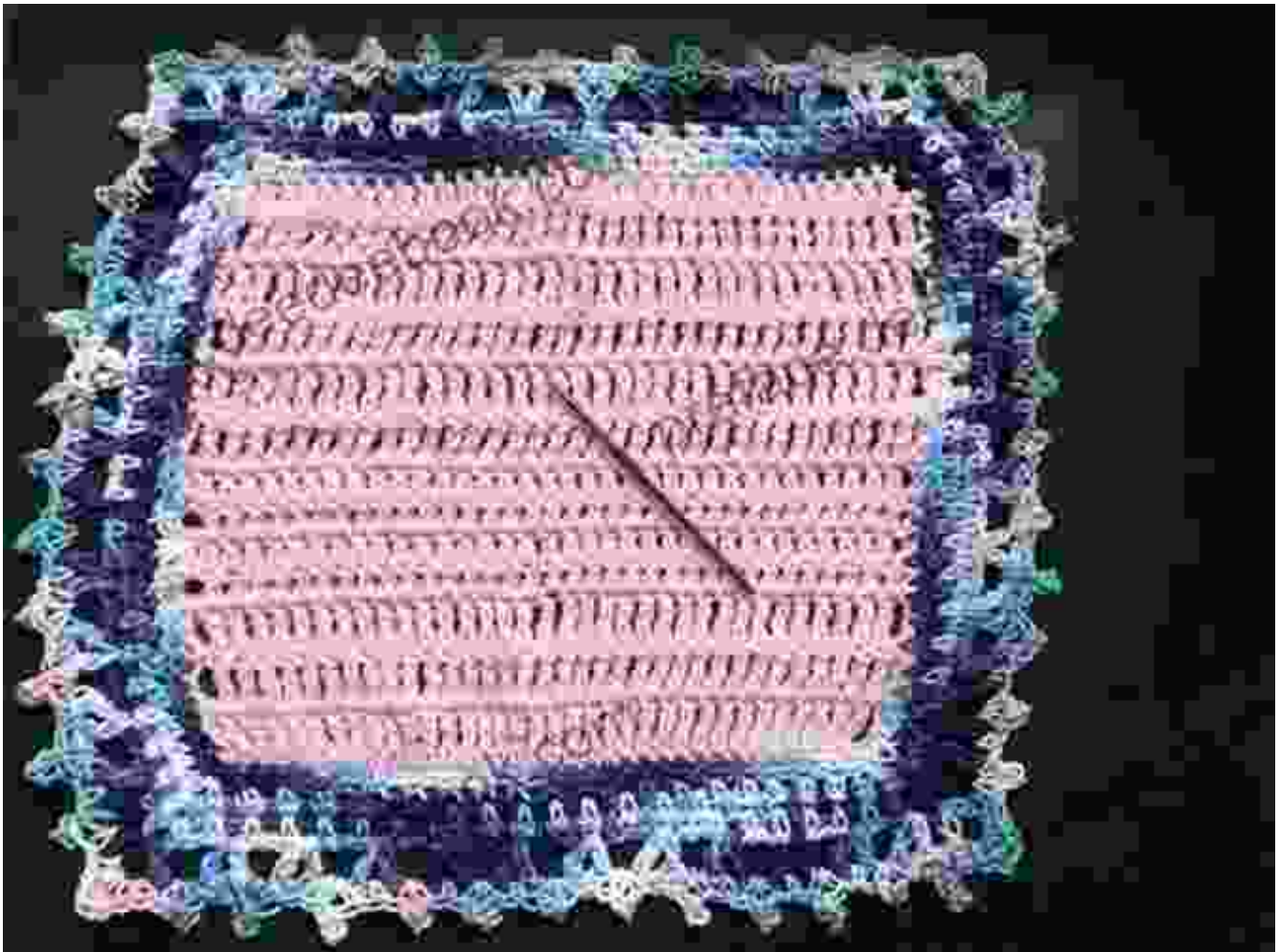
