- 6. Round 11: *1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc* repeat around, ss in first sc to close (24 sc)
- 7. Round 12: 1 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (24 sc)

Muzzle: Embroidering Snoopy's Distinctive Smile

- Embroider a downward curve in black thread onto the muzzle for the mouth.
- 2. Embroider two small nostrils in brown thread just above the mouth.

Body: Building Snoopy's Cozy Beagle Frame

- 1. Round 1: Magic ring, 6 sc in ring, ss in first sc to close (6 sc)
- 2. Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (12 sc)

- 3. Round 3-6: 1 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (12 sc)
- 4. Round 7: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc* repeat around, ss in first sc to close (18 sc)
- 5. Round 8-14: 1 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (18 sc)
- 6. Round 15: *1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc* repeat around, ss in first sc to close (24 sc)
- 7. Round 16-20: 1 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (24 sc)

Legs: Crafting Snoopy's Sturdy Limbs

- 1. Front legs (make 2):
- 2. Round 1: Magic ring, 6 sc in ring, ss in first sc to close (6 sc)
- 3. Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (12 sc)
- 4. Round 3-4: 1 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (12 sc)
- 5. Round 5: *1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc* repeat around, ss in first sc to close (18 sc)
- 6. Round 6-8: 1 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (18 sc)
- 7. Back legs (make 2):
- 8. Magic ring, 6 sc in ring, ss in first sc to close (6 sc)
- 9. Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (12 sc)
- 10. Round 3-5: 1 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (12 sc)
- 11. Round 6: *1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc* repeat around, ss in first sc to close (18 sc)

12. Round 7-10: 1 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (18 sc)

Tail: Creating Snoopy's Signature Tail

- 1. Round 1: Magic ring, 6 sc in ring, ss in first sc to close (6 sc)
- 2. Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (12 sc)
- 3. Round 3: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc* repeat around, ss in first sc to close (18 sc)
- 4. Round 4-12: 1 sc in each sc around, ss in first sc to close (18 sc)

Assembly: Bringing Snoopy's Parts Together

- 1. Sew the muzzle onto the head.
- 2. Sew the body to the head.
- 3. Sew the legs to the body.
- 4. Sew the tail to the body.

Finishing Touches: Adding Snoopy's Charming Details

- 1. Embroider two small black eyes onto the face.
- 2. Embroider two pink cheeks onto the face.
- 3. Sew or glue a small black nose onto the muzzle.


