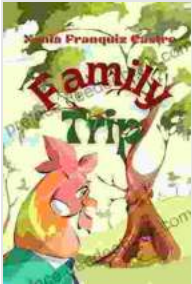

Prayers for Children

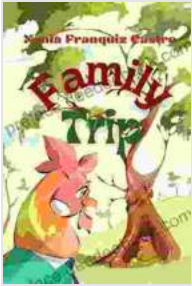
- Dear God,
